Ruedi Baur Presentation and Workshop

Ruedi Baur, an accomplished designer and head of **intégral Ruedi Baur Paris**, will be visiting DAAP **March 7-11, 2016**. This visit will include a workshop and presentation to the **School of Design** and **DAAP** that will focus on the social context of urban space signs. **March 8-10**, **Master of Community Planning** students **Janett Said** and **Anna Snyder** and doctoral candidate **Binita Mahato** will take part in a workshop including multiple disciplines within DAAP, where students will collaborate in teams to develop proposed projects, and design solutions. Baur's culminating presentation will follow this workshop on **March 9, at 7pm in room 5401** and is open to the public. Baur will also give a presentation exclusively to graduate students and faculty on **Thursday, March 10, 12:30–2:00 pm, Room 5430, DAAP** where he will be sharing his concept model for a new interdisciplinary Masters degree.


"Science of Cities" Ebook Available for Free Download!
