## RESIDENTIAL DAAPcamp WELCOME LETTER

Hello! In a very short time, you will be joining us on the University of Cincinnati campus at DAAP (College of Design, Architecture, Art and Planning) for your Pre-College Residential DAAP camp Experiece. We have attached to this note a campus parking map to reference for your arrival and departure per the information included here, we have also attached a FAQ list for frequently asked camp questions, and a suggested highlight list for packing...things not to forget!

## CHECK-IN AND PARKING FOR ARRIVAL:

Check in will be at Scioto Hall at 2921 Scioto Lane and you will be living in the brand new Marian Spencer Hall which is connected to Scioto Hall via a glass hallway bridge. A map to Scioto Hall may be found at this link:

You may park in the University Garage which is directly across the street from Scioto or you may pull up on Scioto Lane briefly to unload. If you have much to unload, we recommend checking in and getting your room access card before carrying everything up.

We will begin on Sunday, June 24th:

CHECK IN is 1pm-3:00pm at Scioto Hall ...you will be residing in Marian Spencer next to Scioto. (See schedule Following.)

You will meet the House Leads at check in who will live in with the camp all week. We have attached a full campus map, but the link above will allow you to pull up directions directly to Scioto and to University Garage directly across the street.

CHECK IN- Scioto Hall is on the right upper side of the map. It is accessible from Jefferson Avenue to Scioto Lane or Scioto Lane off Martin Luther King. It is directly across Scioto Lane from the Dark Blue highlighted University Avenue Garage. You may park in that garage upon drop off. It is the closest to Scitot. Look for the DAAPcamp Signs and Camp Crew in BLACK CREW T SHIRTS...there will be check-in tables set up. You will check in with our CREW on the first level...then proceed to the Housing Staff on the same level to get your room / meal card and be able to take your items into your room.)

\*\*Please Note: Attached to this email and also on our web site are 2 consent forms for the Campus Recreation Center that you need to bring, signed by a parent, and turn in at Check-In. If the camper is 18, they may sign the forms. These are required to enter and utilize the award-winning Campus Recreation Center, we will have some extras at camp check-in, but it is much more efficient if you bring the forms, already signed, with you. Thank you!

After check in...you may stay parked in University garage and walk...or drive to DAAP. You will notice the DAAP complex in the upper left hand corner of the map, Clifton Court is marked in yellow off of Clifton Avenue. We recommend if you are parking or dropping off as a parent ...you may use the meters along Clifton Avenue and MLK . <u>DO NOT PARK IN zoned or decal-only areas...you WILL BE TICKETED! ## **CAMP KICK-OFF!**

DAAPCAMP Orientation begins at 3:30pm in Lecture Hall 4400 in the DAAP Building. The room will be well marked and way finding signs will be around the building. We recommend picking up a bite to eat after check in and before orientation if you have not had lunch...there are many choices in the perimeter areas of campus. Just ask the House Leads when you check in! Parents are welcome to attend orientation and sit in the top of the auditorium. Campers will sit in Design Discipline Groups at the front of the auditorium. You will meet the faculty and find out about what the week will hold. You will also receive an orientation to the Design Disciplines at DAAP and find out what makes the DAAP Experience SO UNIQUE! Following orientation, we will take a tour of DAAP. Parents are also welcome on the tour. Immediately following the tour it becomes "Campers Only" and we move on to dinner and the evening's activities.

5:30 or 6 pm Following the DAAP Tour... we will have pizza dinner at DAAP in the cafe!

6:45 pm You will then be given a tour of the UC campus and the CRC...the Recreation Center, and all of the recreation facilities available to you during the week (pool, basketball court, workout facilities, climbing wall, etc.). You will see the incredible facilities available on an urban campus such as the University of Cincinnati. Campers will experience an opening team building event following their campus tour.

9 pm Program ends for the evening. Back to the residence hall for some chill time.

11 pm Quiet Time begins in the Residence Hall! Please see the "Residence Hall Policies" Agreement which you were required to sign in your Camper Packet for your required Residence Hall Guidelines. You are expected to comply with all Residence Hall Regulations during your stay with us.

Laurie L. Wilson, camp director and "Camp Mom" aka "Mama Wilson" will be the resident chaperone living on site in Scioto Hall with the campers. There will also be Camp House Leads (young adult DAAP graduate or upper-class students) living in the Hall. The Residence Hall Policies states all information you will need to know about the security and individual responsibility in the halls. We have certified first-aid trained chaperones and one of our House Leads is a doctor of physical therapy and lives in with us for any immediate care needs.

## Monday-Friday:

You will follow a daily schedule that fluctuates a bit, depending upon the course work for the day or if there will be a field trip, etc. Most days begin at 8 am in DAAP for breakfast unless otherwise noted by your faculty/house leads. You will meet each morning leave your housing in groups led by your house leads between 7:30 and 7:45am. You will eat breakfast at DAAP as a group. All field trips during the week will be chaperoned by faculty, camp leaders and/or the camp director. If traveling, we will do so in school buses with professional drivers.

There is programming and free time each evening as well. Please remember, 3 meals a day are provided by camp along with snacks in your studios and classrooms. If you like to snack in the evenings or have any special snacking or dietary needs, we recommend you bringing your own snacks with you so you will have what you want when you want it. Also...this is covered in the Packing List and FAQ's (which can all be also found on the DAAPCamps' Web Site...but, a light blanket, sheets, a pillow and a regular size bath towel and wash cloth are provided for each camper...however, that is ALL. We recommend bringing extra comforter or pillow if you like to sleep with more...along with personal soap, etc. This is not a hotel, it is a basic dorm room, so we do not have shampoo, soap, etc.) Mama Wilson does have emergency items if you happen to forget something...so do not worry...but, try to come PREPARED! Also, each suite of rooms has a microwave and a small fridge provided, so you have that for your use as well.

END OF WEEK SHOW: SATURDAY, JUNE 30th 9am-11am at DAAP, Followed by DAAPcamp Graduation at 11:00am. DAAPworks is the annual presentation of Student Work at DAAP. During DAAPcamps, you will have your own Mini DAAPworks Exhibition on the third, fourth, fifth floor exhibition space of DAAP. Designers and guests will enjoy light refreshments and music while they view the work of our campers!

This is a public exhibition so you will be given the opportunity to invite friends and family to see your work and the work of your fellow designers. Students will exhibit their work

in a gallery setting with interactive elements and all designers will have a chance to view and appreciate others' work.

THIS SHOW WILL HAPPEN SATURDAY Morning, June 30th from 9-11.

The Fashion Design Camp Fashion Show Happens at approximately 10:00am in the DAAP Cafe'..graduation follows in Lecture Hall 4400 at 11 until approximately noon.

(Immediately following graduation, all campers are asked to vacate Marian Spencer Hall and you will participate in room check-out and return all keys and cards..we advise that you are pre-packed and rooms ready to vacate...it makes your departure much more efficient!)

\*\*Please Note: Airport Shuttle Transportation both from the airport on June 24th and to the airport on June 30th is complimentary if the traveler is able to travel with the group transportation.
