



## RESIDENTIAL DAAPcamp WELCOME LETTER

Hello! In a very short time, you will be joining us on the University of Cincinnati campus at DAAP (College of Design, Architecture, Art and Planning) for your Pre-College Residential DAAPcamp Experience. We have attached to this note a campus parking map to reference for your arrival and departure per the information included here, we have also attached a FAQ list for frequently asked camp questions, and a suggested highlight list for packing...things not to forget!

### CHECK-IN AND PARKING FOR ARRIVAL:

We will begin on Sunday, June 19th: CHECK IN is 1pm-3:00pm at the Turner Residence Hall Complex. (See schedule Following.) You will meet the House Leads at check in who will live in with the camp all week. Please refer to the attached campus parking map.

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CHECK IN- Turner Hall is on the right upper side of the map. It is accessible from Jefferson Avenue. It is directly across West University Avenue from the Dark Blue highlighted University Avenue Garage. You may park in that garage upon drop off. It is the closest to Turner. Look for the DAAPcamp Signs and Camp Crew in RED T SHIRTS...there will be check-in tables set up. You will check in with our CREW...then proceed into Turner to get your room key and meal card and be able to take your items into your room. )

After check in...you may stay parked in that garage and walk...or drive to DAAP. You will notice the DAAP complex in the upper left hand corner of the map, Clifton Court is marked in yellow off of Clifton Avenue. We recommend if you are parking or dropping off as a parent ...you may use the meters along Clifton Avenue and MLK or, you may proceed down Clifton Court and park in the Clifton Court Garage...highlighted in bright blue on the map. **DO NOT PARK IN zoned or decal-only areas...you WILL BE TICKETED! DAAPcamp is not responsible for tickets. Please park in metered or garage areas only. Thank you!**

## **CAMP KICK-OFF!**

**DAAPCAMP Orientation begins at 3:30pm in Lecture Hall 4400 in the DAAP Building. The room will be well marked and way finding signs will be around the building. We recommend picking up a bite to eat after check in and before orientation if you have not had lunch...there are many choices in the perimeter areas of campus. Just ask the House Leads when you check in!**

Parents are welcome to attend orientation and sit in the top of the auditorium. Campers will sit in Design Discipline Groups. You will meet the faculty and find out about what the week will hold. You will also receive an orientation to the Design Disciplines at DAAP and find out what makes the DAAP Experience SO UNIQUE! Following orientation, we will take a tour of DAAP. Parents are also welcome on the tour. Immediately following the tour it becomes "Campers Only" and we move on to dinner and the evening's activities.

5:30 or 6 pm Following the DAAP Tour... we will have pizza dinner at DAAP in the cafe!

6:45 pm You will then be given a tour of the UC campus and the CRC...the Recreation Center, and all of the recreation facilities available to you during the week (pool, basketball court, workout facilities, climbing wall, etc.). You will see the incredible facilities available on an urban campus such as the University of Cincinnati. Campers will experience an opening team building event following their campus tour.

9 pm Program ends for the evening. Back to the residence halls for some chill time.

11 pm Quiet Time begins in the Residence Hall! Please see the "Residence Hall Policies" Agreement for your required Residence Hall Guidelines. You are expected to comply with all Residence Hall Regulations during your stay with us.

Laurie L. Wilson, camp director and "Camp Mom" will be the resident chaperone living on site in Turner Hall with the campers. There will also be camp houseleads (young adult DAAP graduate or upper-class students) living in the Hall. The Residence Hall Policies states all information you will need to know about the security and individual responsibility in the halls. We have certified first-aid trained chaperones and one of our House Leads is a medical doctoral student.

### **Monday–Friday:**

You will follow a daily schedule that fluctuates a bit, depending upon the course work for the day or if there will be a field trip, etc. Most days begin at 8 am in DAAP for breakfast unless otherwise noted by your faculty. You will eat breakfast at DAAP as a group. All field trips during the week will be chaperoned by faculty, camp leaders and/or the camp director. If traveling, we will do so in school buses with professional drivers.

**END OF WEEK SHOW: SATURDAY, JUNE 25th 9am-11am at DAAP, Followed by DAAPcamp Graduation at 11:00am. DAAPworks** is the annual presentation of Student Work at DAAP. During DAAPcamps, you will have your own Mini DAAPworks Exhibition on the Third, fourth, fifth floor exhibition space of DAAP. Designers and guests will enjoy light refreshments and a live DJ while they view the work of our campers!

This is a public exhibition so you will be given the opportunity to invite friends and family to see your work and the work of your fellow designers. Students will exhibit their work in a gallery setting with interactive elements and all designers will have a chance to view and appreciate others' work.
