Advanced Level Electives

Exceptions

Professional Elective
 Professional electives (6 credits): any non-studio course in INTD, ARCH, or HORT; such courses may require permission of the instructor. Graduate seminars may be taken for undergraduate credit with the permission of the instructor. If you are using a graduate level course to satisfy an undergraduate requirement, you must submit a "Graduate Level Course Credit" waiver form in the College of DAAP Dean's Office, room 5470 Aronoff; forms can also be obtained at that location.
