Applications received after the priority deadlines will be reviewed on a space-available basis.

High school students:

Apply online at admissions.uc.edu/apply using The Common Application beginning August 1. For priority admission and maximum scholarship consideration apply by **December 1**.

Transfer students:

Apply online at admissions.uc.edu/apply beginning August 1. For priority admission consideration apply by **March 1**.
