## [International Students Estimated Annual Expenses, UC International June, 2024:](#)

*All international students coming on F-1 or J-1 visas must demonstrate that they have financial support for their programs of study, including tuition, fees and living expenses. With inflation and other world events of the past two years, the cost of living has increased substantially. Student expenditure surveys, comparisons of local prices, federal reports, etc. have led us, in consultation with Student Financial Aid and University Housing, to conclude that our estimated annual living expenses must increase significantly. Most graduate students will now need to demonstrate annual support of \$53,827.*
